



# Emergency Supply Kit

*It is best to prepare before a disaster happens by assembling the following supplies in advance.*

	<b>Short Term Emergency</b> (Evacuation lasting up to 6 hours) <i>Pack listed supplies in a backpack, wheeled bin, or wheeled duffle bag</i>	<b>72-Hour Emergency</b> <i>Pack listed supplies in a sturdy, waterproof tote with wheels or garbage can with wheels</i>
<b>Important Papers*</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Emergency information on each child in a small notebook or on cards</li> <li>Emergency plan and numbers</li> <li>Care plans</li> <li>Medical releases</li> <li>Relocation site agreements and maps</li> </ul>	All short-term supplies PLUS <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Emergency Transportation Permission</li> </ul>
<b>Water**</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>One-two gallons of water for every 4 children/staff</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>One gallon per person per day</li> </ul>
<b>Food Infant Formula Labeled Breast Milk</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Non-perishable food items(i.e.: granola bars,crackers, cereal, etc.). Consider food allergies of currently enrolled children.</li> <li>Formula /appropriate (pre-packaged) food for infants</li> <li>Breast milk stored in small cooler</li> <li>Disposable cups, plates, utensils, bowls, including infant bottles</li> </ul>	All short-term supplies PLUS <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Extra formula/appropriate food for infants</li> <li>Extra non-perishable food</li> <li>Canned fruits and meat</li> <li>Non-electric can opener</li> </ul>
<b>Clothing and Bedding</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Emergency blankets</li> <li>Pair of work gloves</li> </ul>	All short-term supplies PLUS <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Change of clothes per person, especially socks and underwear</li> <li>Extra bedding/blankets</li> <li>Emergency blankets (one per person)</li> </ul>
<b>First Aid</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Small first aid kit</li> <li>Any needed medications (Epi-Pen, Insulin, etc.) for children/staff with special needs</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Large first aid kit</li> <li>Any needed medications (Epi-Pen, Insulin, etc.) for children/staff with special needs</li> </ul>
<b>Sanitation</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Diapers and wipes</li> <li>Tissues</li> <li>Toilet paper</li> <li>Paper Towels</li> <li>Hand sanitizer</li> <li>Disinfecting wipes</li> </ul>	All short-term supplies PLUS <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Extra diapers and wipes</li> <li>5-gallon plastic bucket with toilet seat</li> <li>Large garbage bags/plastic bags -various sizes</li> <li>Extra disinfecting wipes</li> <li>Extra hand sanitizer</li> <li>Extra paper products</li> <li>Feminine supplies</li> </ul>
<b>Comfort and Safety</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>At least one age appropriate play activity</li> <li>Flashlight with batteries or crank-style</li> <li>Paper and pen</li> <li>Dust/filter masks (1 per person)</li> <li>Towels</li> <li>Utility knife or multi-tool</li> <li>Teething rings/pacifiers</li> <li>Walking rope</li> <li>Emergency cash</li> <li>Mosquito repellent and sunscreen</li> </ul>	All short-term supplies PLUS <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Additional age appropriate play activities to rotate</li> <li>Glow sticks</li> <li>Extra batteries for flashlights</li> <li>Emergency cash</li> <li>Waterproof tarps, duct tape and plastic sheeting</li> </ul>
<b>Communication</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>NOAA weather radio (battery or crank powered)</li> <li>Cell phone charger</li> <li>Portable power pack</li> </ul>	All short-term supplies PLUS <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Walkie-talkie</li> <li>Non-electric phone</li> <li>Signal/flare</li> </ul>

**\*\* Store in a resealable plastic bag or a waterproof container.**

**\*Water will most likely not fit into a backpack. Store in a way that can be taken easily in an emergency (roller bag/crate with wheels, etc).**
